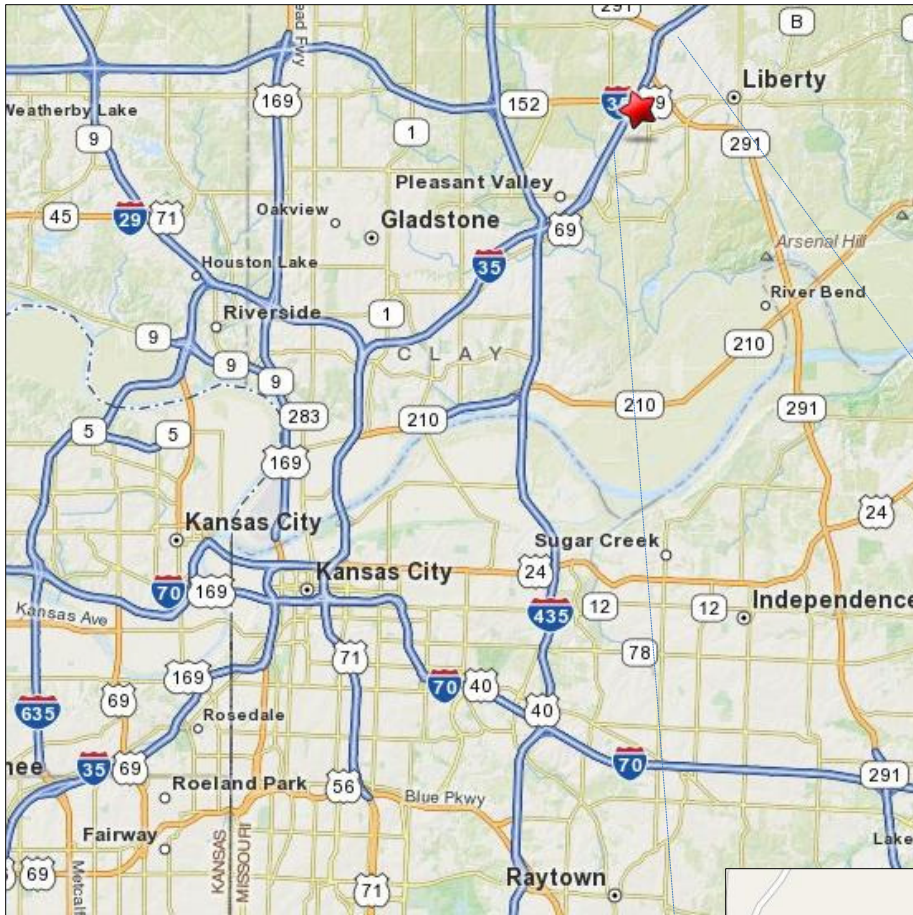

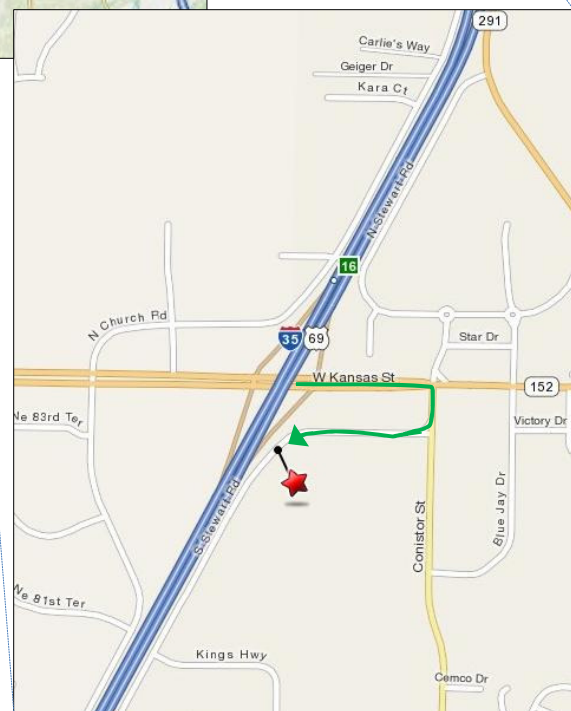
Within 1 mile of St. James are several dozen restaurants including:

Drive east on Hwy 152 less than a ¼ mile.
Take first right at light – Conistor St
Take first right – Stewart Rd
Follow Stewart Rd ½ mile to Church
